Position Title: Membership, Diversity and Inclusion Chair

Overview: The Membership, Diversity and Inclusion Chair is responsible for oversight of all of the membership activities of the APA, including the Regions and SIGs, New Century Scholars Program, membership, the Membership Diversity and Inclusion Executive and related subcommittees and task forces.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Attends and participates in APA Board Meetings and annual meeting-related events
- Chairs APA's Membership, Diversity and Inclusion Executive Committee and reports to the Board of Directors on activities
- Provides strategic direction as needed to Membership, Diversity and Inclusion Executive sub-committees and task forces
- Serves and participates on the *Academic Pediatrics* Committee
- Provides oversight and participates in leadership meetings and decisions for the New Century Scholars Programs
- Serves as the partnership point-of-contact for any New Century Scholars (NCS) sponsoring organizations (currently ABP and APS)
- Oversees grant application and renewal for NCS
- Oversees selection of the APA Faculty, Teaching and mentoring awards
- Assists with the orientation and transition to the next Chair
- Leads regular APA Membership, Diversity and Inclusion Executive Committee Calls to hear updates on all APA membership activities and troubleshoot any areas of concern
- Review all APA membership applications
