Advancing Pediatric Educator eXcellence (APEX) Teaching Program is an award-winning national faculty development program in clinical teaching co-sponsored by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Section on Hospital Medicine and the Academic Pediatric Association (APA). Designed for those who are interested in expanding their clinical teaching skillset, the program includes:

- 13-month blended learning experience providing evidence-based teaching strategies, exemplar faculty mentorship, and a forum to collaborate with peers around clinical teaching topics
- Half-day session of workshops at the "anchor" meeting (PAS or PHM) in two consecutive years
- Longitudinal online learning program between anchor meetings
