Position Title: Health Care Delivery Chair

Overview: The Health Care Delivery Chair is a member of the Board of Directors and is responsible for oversight of all the health care delivery-related activities of the APA, including the QI improvement science meeting, the Quality and Safety Improvement Scholars Program, the Health Care Delivery Award and related sub-committees and task forces.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Attends and participates in APA Board Meetings and annual meeting-related events
- Chairs APA's Health Care Delivery Committee and reports to the Board of Directors on activities
- Provides strategic direction as needed to the Health Care Delivery's and its subcommittees and task forces
- Provides oversight and participates in leadership meetings and decisions for the Quality and Safety Improvement Scholars Program and the annual Quality Improvement Conference
- Assists with the orientation and transition to the next Chair

• Reports to the Board of Directors

Qualifications

- Active engagement with the APA and/or its health care delivery programs
- Experience in implementing innovative health care delivery programs and initiatives

Time Commitment:

- 4-6 hours a month including
 - o at least four monthly teleconference meetings for activities described above
 - o two annual in-person meetings of the Board (one prior to PAS)

- meetings at PAS representing the Health Care Delivery Committee and Board of Directors
- o quarterly Health Care Delivery Committee teleconference meetings not including one annual in-person meeting at PAS
- o QI improvement science meeting planning meetings (as needed)
- Quality and Safety Improvement Scholars Program leadership meetings (as needed)
